



Safeguarding Guidelines and Contacts

We are committed to creating a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for everyone.

Key Safeguarding Points:

- All children, young people, and adults must be treated with respect and dignity.
- No one should ever feel unsafe, threatened, or excluded in this space.
- Any concerns about safety or wellbeing must be reported immediately.
- Physical contact must be appropriate and only when necessary.
- Always maintain professional boundaries.
- Always use appropriate language and behaviour.
- Photography or filming requires prior consent.
- Bullying, harassment, or discrimination will not be tolerated.
- All volunteers and staff must follow our safeguarding policy.
- First aid kits and emergency contact details are available on site.

If you are worried about a child or adult's safety or have concerns about another members behaviour:

- Speak to a **Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)** or if not available the **Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead (DDSL)** immediately.
- You can also report concerns anonymously if needed.
- All concerns will be taken seriously and handled confidentially.
